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DO'S AND DON'T FOR STUDENTS

- 1) Every student is expected to keep the good name of the school by his/her conduct and behaviour.
- 2) It is compulsory for the students to complete 75% of attendance during the session to make them eligible to take the annual examination. It is also compulsory for the students to attend extra/special classes as notified by the school.
- 3) Students should carry this almanac to school every day.
- 4) Commendation cards are given to students who deserve them as taken of appreciation for any outstanding behavior, good work observance of school regulations, or any other praiseworthy achievement.
- 5) No exemption can be granted from the compulsory games, P.T. and any activity unless a doctor's certification is submitted.
- 6) When students leave the classroom, the lights and fans must be switched off.
- 7) Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than three consecutive days renders the students liable to have his /her name struck off the rolls. Readmission may be granted only after payment of a fresh admission fee.
- 8) Students are supposed to use leave application from compulsory in case of absence.
- 9) Students are allowed to wear formals on their birth days.
- 10) Any kind of damage to school property must be care for.
- 11) Students who are not availing the school bus facilities should arrive in the school 5 minutes before the first bell.
- 12) Students who habitually keep indulging in misbehavior despite repeated warning and continuous efforts by school teachers/counselors, to improve upon their behaviour , will not be enrolled/admitted in the school during the following academic session. The warning in this regard will be given to academic session. The warning in this regard will be given to parents well in advance. The students will be liable for defaulter's remark on the following grounds
 - a) Absence from assembly (while present in campus)
 - b) Absence from 'Class' and unexplained loitering.
 - c) Scribbling graffiti.
 - d) Unruly movements or unseemly noise in the corridors or inside the building.
 - e) Insubordination
 - f) Bullying and usage of foul language.
 - g) Wearing improper incorrect or incomplete uniform,
 - h) Late coming.
 - i) Miss-Conduct while travelling in the school bus.
 - j) Stealing etc.
